Head Winemaker/Vineyard Consultant. Apply by resume to: John Martini, Anthony Road Wine Company, 1020 Anthony Road, Penn Yan, NY 14527. The applicant must have legal authority to accept employment with the Anthony Road Wine Company in the United States. This position is based in Penn Yan, NY.

The position of Head Winemaker/Vineyard Consultant includes the following duties: (1) Lead and direct all phases of the winemaking process using various grape varieties, including Riesling, Pinot, Cabernet Franc, and Vignoles; (2) Anticipate and respond to winemaking challenges posed by cool climate viticulture. Recommend and help select the equipment necessary to meet those challenges; (3) Perform chemical and biological testing and monitoring of wine production; (4) Monitor fermentations by taste and analysis and make fermentation, blending, and fining decisions; (5) Review and evaluate all facets of wine production as they relate to stylistic and qualitative guidelines; (6) Monitor wine inventory to ensure quality is maintained through routine cellar operations, temperature control, analytical testing, and tastings; (7) Be able to operate and maintain production and bottling equipment, including pad-cross-flow, sterile and DE filtration equipment; (8) Work with winery owners to create new blends and wines based on the specific attributes of each year's crop and market changes; (9) Maintain required TTB records and detailed information on all bulk and bottled wines; (10) Investigate new techniques, perform industry research, and develop new processes to improve grape and wine quality; (11) Provide input to vineyard owners/managers on the management of vineyard operations to achieve optimum grape quality, including harvest decisions; (12) Supervise and instruct winemaking staff on cleaning, set-up and operation of equipment during the winemaking process; and (13) Assist with public relations/marketing activities and represent the winery at wine-related functions.

The Head Winemaker/Vineyard Consultant position requires at least (1) a Bachelor's degree, or its equivalent, in viticulture and enology; (2)

Five years of progressive experience in winemaking, including at least 4 years of experience with cool climate grape growing and winemaking and at least 5 years of experience working with Riesling and Pinot Noir; (3) Two years of hands-on experience working in a cool climate organic vineyard and winery; (4) Production experience making methode champenoise sparkling wine; and (5) Production experience making true TBA wines with botrytised grapes.
